

JMA Standard Dress

The following applies to ALL students of ALL grades.

PANTS/SHORTS/SKIRTS/DRESSES etc.

- Trousers, pants, jeans, shorts, capris, skirts, skorts, jumper dresses, dresses in solid dark blue (navy), black, or khaki (tan) are permitted.
- Only solid colors may be worn. No variations of the stated colors will be permitted.
- Hem length of shorts/skorts/skirts/dresses must be no shorter than 4" above the knees.
- Pants may not have visible holes.
- Leggings, jeggings, yoga, or pajama bottom style garments are prohibited.
- Pants, shorts, and skirts must be worn at the natural waist and may not reveal undergarments.
- Messages or advertising on any of the above items are prohibited.
- Clothing should be appropriately sized and clean

SHIRTS/BLOUSES/TOPS

- Polos, button-up shirts, blouses, t-shirts in solid dark blue (navy), white or red are permitted.
- Only solid colors may be worn. No variations of the stated colors will be permitted.
- Tank tops, spaghetti-strap, tube tops, and halter-tops are prohibited.
- Shirts/tops may not reveal undergarments or midriff, navel or cleavage.
- Messages or advertising on any of the above items are prohibited.
- Clothing should be appropriately sized.

SWEATERS/SWEATSHIRTS/OUTERWEAR

- Sweaters, windbreakers, sweatshirts, hoodies that are worn in the classroom in solid dark blue (navy) red, gray, or black are permitted.
- Standard attire shirts/tops MUST be worn under any item of outerwear.
- Hoods of any outerwear may NOT be worn in the campus buildings.

SHOES

- Shoes that are acceptable include athletic or tennis shoes, closed toe sandals with heel straps, oxfords, loafers or boots.
- Flip-flops, crocs, house shoes or slippers are prohibited.
- Bare feet are prohibited.

ACCESSORIES, HEAD GEAR and BODY DECORATION

- Earrings may be worn. Other pierced areas of the face or body not covered by clothing must be removed or replaced with a blank. (Protected cultural or religious hairstyles, body markings, or piercings are exempted.)
- Other body decorations such as tattoos, drawings, etc. that are distracting or offensive shall be completely covered by clothing to the extent possible. (Protected cultural or religious hairstyles, body markings, or piercings are exempted.)
- Clothing, accessories or jewelry that presents a hazard to the student's safety or causes a disruption of the learning process is prohibited. Example: Body chains (other than necklaces or bracelets), spiked jewelry, gloves.
- Headgear, except for recognized religious purposes, is prohibited. This includes bandanas, beanies, and caps.

PE DRESS CODE

- Red, white, light dark blue (navy), or navy short sleeved T-shirts and/or sweatshirts
- No tank tops or spaghetti straps allowed.
- Athletic shorts or sweatpants in navy blue, red, black, or gray.
- Basketball shorts with piping is acceptable for PE.
- PE apparel will be worn during PE class only.
